### General Guide on Prices of Conversions

This Information Sheet aims to provide a **general guide** only on the typical cost of converting vehicles for disabled people to use as a driver or as a passenger. You should always check prices with the adaptation firms and we recommend you have written quotes before committing to a purchase.

This list is not exhaustive nor does it claim to be definitive. The price guides are approximate and current at the Autumn 2007.
